1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the Digest?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioners are claiming step up of their pay to that given to their juniors. Learned counsel states that in this regard the petitioners have got served a legal notice dated 05.02.2015(Annexure P-6) on the respondents and at this stage the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time .

I find this to be a fair request.

Resultantly this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice(Annexure P-6) of the petitioners within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order in accordance with law by passing a speaking order thereon and in case the petitioners are found entitled to any relief, grant them the same

within another period of one month thereafter. Since the dispute in this case relates to monetary benefits, it is made clear that in case any due payment is not made within the aforesaid time, the petitioners would be entitled to claim the same with interest at the rate of 8% p.a. from the date/s the payment/s fell due.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
