By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks quashing of the impugned letter dated 02.03.2015 (Annexure P-6), vide which the petitioner has been denied the interest on the delayed payment of retiral benefits.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner had served legal notice dated 04.09.2014 (Annexure P-4), however, no interest on the delayed payments has been paid so far. It is further asserted that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down in **The Financial Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Irrigation Department, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh Vs. Hasan Singh Kanwar, 2010(1) SLR 788.**

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to reconsider the claim of the petitioner and decide the same, in terms of **Hasan Singh Kanwar's** case, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
