AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioners have claimed promotion with effect from the date their juniors have been promoted . Learned counsel states that the petitioners have also sent representation dated 09.10.2014(Annexure P-10) to the respondent No.2 and prays that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation in accordance with law within any reasonable time by passing a speaking order thereon.

I find this to be a fair request.

Resultantly this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-10) of the petitioners within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order in accordance with law by passing a speaking order thereon and in case the petitioners are found entitled to any relief, grant the same to them within a period of one month thereafter.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc.
Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
