By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to the respondents to revise the pension/family pension along with dearness allowance admissible, in view of the letter dated 07.11.2014, issued by the Govt. of Haryana.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of their grievances, the petitioners had moved representations dated 05.12.2014 (Annexure P-7) and Annexure P-8, however, the benefits have not been released so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the representations, Annexure P-7 and P-8, in terms of law laid down in **Satyapal Yadav and another V. State of Haryana and another**, rendered in CWP No. 19266 of 2010, decided on 25.07.2012 (Annexure P-4), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
