RAJIVE BHALLA, J (ORAL)

The petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that petitions under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act'), filed for eviction of unauthorised occupants, in possession of 153 acres of land, are not being finalised on account of collusion between the unauthorised occupants and certain influential persons.

Counsel for the petitioner prays that the Assistant Collector, 1st Grade, may be directed to decide the petitions, filed under Section 7 of the Act, expeditiously.

Counsel for the State of Haryana submits that petitions, filed under Section 7 of the Act, are pending adjudication, before the Assistant Collector, 1st Grade, Indri

and shall be disposed of expeditiously.

We have heard counsel for the parties and after taking into consideration, statement made by counsel for the State of Haryana, direct the Assistant Collector, 1st Grade Indri-respondent No.4, to decide all the petitions pending, under Section 7 of the Act, within six months of the receipt of a certified copy of this order.
