After arguing for some time, when this court was not inclined to go into the validity of Rule 14 of the Haryana Excise and Taxation Inspectorate (State Service, Class C) Rules, 1969 (Annexure P-11), learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners may be permitted to submit a representation with regard to reduction of standard of the departmental examination, keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have been promoted to the post of Taxation Inspectors from the cadre of Clerks, for whom the minimum requisite educational qualification is Matriculation, whereas the persons appearing in the departmental examination, who are directly appointed as Excise & Taxation Officers have the minimum educational qualification of Graduation. Learned counsel states that the

petitioners will also submit representation for granting them exemption from appearing in the departmental examination by the competent authority, as allegedly has been earlier granted to various persons.

In view of the above, we permit the petitioners to submit the representation, as stated above. If any such representation is submitted, respondents No.2 and 3 are directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months, by passing a speaking order.

Disposed of accordingly.
