ARUN PALLI, J.(ORAL):-

A writ in the nature of certiorari is prayed for, so as to quash the order dated 23.04.2015 (Annexure P3), issued by respondent No.2, whereby the petitioner has been transferred from D.R.D.A. District Ferozepur to D.R.D.A District Fazilka. And in the alternative, a direction is sought to the respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 24.04.2015 (Annexure P6), made by the petitioner.

It is maintained that prior to the institution of this petition, petitioner had represented to respondent No.3 against his transfer vide representation dated 24.04.2015 (Annexure P6). And in response, respondent No.3, vide letter dated 24.04.2015 (Annexure P7) has recommended the cancellation of transfer of the petitioner to Joint Development Commissioner-cum-Special Secretary, Punjab

Government (respondent No.2). However, no formal order has yet been passed by respondent No.2 and, thus, his representation continues to await consideration. He submits that let this petition be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide his representation dated 24.04.2015 (Annexure P6), within a specified time.

That being so, and, without expressing any opinion on merits, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner as set out in his representation dated 24.04.2015 (Annexure P6), strictly, in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks, from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. Needless to assert, a comprehensive order shall be passed assigning reasons, in support of the decision arrived at.
