AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

By this order, I propose to decide Civil Writ Petition Nos.9287 and 10466 of 2015, wherein award dated 20.02.2015 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Permanent Lok Adalat, Bathinda, has been challenged.

The primary contention of the counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner has been directed to pay compensation of ₹30,000/- to the applicant (respondent No.2 herein), whereas there has been no harassment on the part of the petitioner. She contends that the conclusion, as has been drawn by the Permanent Lok Adalat while assessing the liability of the

petitioner for paying compensation of ₹30,000/- to respondent No.2, which ultimately will come back to the petitioner, the same to be adjusted in the loan account of the deceased, is not legally sustainable.

There appears to be no illegality in the award passed by the Permanent Lok Adalat and in any case ultimately there will be no loss caused to the petitioner as the claim will ultimately be settled by respondent No.3. There is no apparent illegality, which has been committed by the respondent No.1, which would call for any interference of this Court in exercise of its extra ordinary writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India

In view of the above, these writ petitions are dismissed being devoid of merit.
