By way of the instant writ petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to decide the pension case of the petitioner and to release the family pension for the service rendered by her deceased husband.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner had served legal notice dated 14.05.2014 (Annexure P-7), however, the benefits have not been released so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.2, to decide the legal notice Annexure P-7, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
