The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking allotment of 5 marla plot under oustee quota in view of the policy/scheme/notification in the year 1972.

2. After arguing for sometime, when the Court was not inclined to grant the prayer, learned counsel for the petitioner stated that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the concerned authority for the grievance raised in the writ petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
