AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Petitioner has approached this Court with an apprehension that the petitioner would not be allowed to execute and perform the transport contract for loading of Special Train at Rail Head Phillaur from FSD Phillaur by respondents No.8 to 11 along with the associates. Petitioner has made his own arrangements for transportation for execution of the said contract which process of loading and unloading starts from 24.05.2015. The apprehension of the petitioner as of now is merely based on the assumption that he would not be permitted to proceed with the execution and performance of the transport contract allotted to him by the Food Corporation of India dated 20.03.2015 vide which he was intimated that his tender has been accepted.

The pleadings indicate that the present writ petition is premature as the contract is to commence w.e.f. 24.05.2015 and as

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and when such a situation arises as has been apprehended by the petitioner, he may approach the appropriate authorities with his grievance who shall look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law, if so required.

The writ petition is disposed of as premature at this stage.
