The petitioner's precise grievance, as discernible from the pleadings, is that despite an order of ejectment dated 08.06.2012 (Annexure P-1), respondent No.4 continues to remain in unauthorised occupation and neither the Gram Panchayat nor authorities empowered, under the Punjab village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 have taken any steps to take possession of the land, in dispute.

We have heard counsel for the petitioner and perused the paper book.

As is apparent from the order of eviction dated 08.06.2012 (Annexure P-1), the Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Pataudi, after holding that Saroop @ Ram Saroop (respondent No.4) is in illegal possession, ordered his eviction. It, however, appears that the order of eviction has not been implemented.

Consequently, without expressing any opinion as to the rights of the parties, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Pataudi, to adopt the procedure prescribed by Rule 21(2) of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Rules, 1964 and ensure that in the absence of any legal impediment, order dated 08.06.2012 (Annexure P-1) is implemented within two months of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
