By way of present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners pray for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos. 1 to 5 to take action against respondent Nos. 6 and 7 for violating the terms and condition of LOI dated 30.7.2008 and further directing the respondents to provide the basic amenities and to take action against respondents No. 6 and 7 in accordance with law.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach the civil court or any other forum for the grievance raised in the writ petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the

petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
