AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner asserts that on completion of the contract allotted to him, he was even returned his security amount on 23.05.2013 (Annexure P-7), despite that, the bill submitted by the petitioner dated 04.07.2012 (Annexure P-4) has not been released to it till date. Petitioner had been approaching the respondents through various notices, copies of which have been appended as Annexures P-5, P-6 and P-8 but till date no decision has been taken thereon.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Executive Engineer (Operation Division), Punjab, State Power Corporation Limited, Patra, District Patiala-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.02.2015 (Annexure P-8) of the petitioner within some specified time.

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In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the Senior Executive Engineer (Operation Division), Punjab, State Power Corporation Limited, Patra, District Patiala-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.02.2015 (Annexure P-8) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

In case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to the petitioner, in accordance with law, within a further period of four weeks.
