This Civil Writ Petition has been filed, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of directions to the respondents to release gratuity, leave encashment, General Provident Fund and all consequential benefits along with interest @18% per annum.

A letter dated 21.05.2015, filed in the Court, is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.3 refers to the letter dated 21.05.2015, states that entire retiral benefits have been released to the petitioner.

In view of above statement, the learned counsel for the

petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.

In case, if it is found that letter dated 21.05.2015 is against the record, the petitioner shall have the liberty to revive the present petition.

However, the learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no interest has been paid on the delayed payment.

In these circumstances, the petitioner shall have the liberty to represent the respondent No.3 with regard to interest on the delayed payment and respondent No.3 is directed to pass an appropriate order on the same in terms of **The Financial Commissioner & Principal Secretary to Govt. Haryana, Irrigation Department, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh and others Vs. Hasan Singh Kanwar, SDO, LPA No.915 of 2009**, decided on 07.10.2009, within three months from the receipt of such a representation.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid terms.
