AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that despite he having a valid contract in his favour for transportation of lifting the wheat during the Rabi season 2015-16 at Focal Points/Sub-Yeards at Ramgarh and Khassan, Tehsil Bholath, District Kapurthala, he is not being permitted to operate his trucks by the local truck unions/local transporters but this assertion of the counsel for the petitioner is not supported by any request/representation to the concerned authorities highlighting such a grievance as has been projected by the petitioner in the present writ petition. If the allegations made in the writ petition are correct, he should first approach the Competent Authority for redressal of his grievance which could be the District Magistrate or Senior Superintendent of Police.

The writ petition is disposed of with above observations.

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At this stage, counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would approach the District Magistrate, Kapurthala and the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala within a period of one week from today. If such a representation is made and some substance therein is found, appropriate steps including providing protection, in accordance with law, be initiated by the Competent Authority.
