By way of present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to get the obstruction removed from common passage/path in the petitioner-colony to enable the residents to ingress and egress to their respective houses.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the civil court or any other forum for the grievance raised in the writ petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the

petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
