The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for quashing of order dated 07.05.2015 (Annexure P3), whereby the petitioner's request for extension of one year service from 01.04.2015 onwards has been rejected. The reason for rejection is that an FIR has been registered against the employee.

Counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the factum that there is an FIR regarding an incident in which the petitioner is an accused in the cross-case. It is also not disputed that there are instructions that employees who have FIR registered against them are not entitled for extension. In such circumstances, the order which is under challenge does not suffer from any infirmity as the concession of extension has been declined on a valid basis, as per the parameters set out which would not warrant any interference by this Court. It is, however, submitted that the petitioner has worked from 01.04.2015 till 07.05.2015. If this is the case, the respondents shall ensure that the petitioner is given the requisite financial benefits for the said period.

With the abovesaid observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
