It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was allotted work order Nos.90 and 91 dated 06.12.2014 by respondent No.2. The work was completed by the petitioner on 25.12.2014. Till date the amount due to the petitioner has not been released. Petitioner has even served a legal notice dated 24.03.2015 (Annexure P-5) upon the respondents but that also has not been responded to.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents 2 and 3, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 24.03.2015 (Annexure P-5) within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to Executive Engineer, Head Works Division Ropar, District Ropar and S.D.O. Sub Division Officer

Doraha, Sub Division, S.C. Doraha, District Ludhiana-respondents 2 and 3 respectively, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 24.03.2015 (Annexure P-5), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to it, in accordance with law, within a further period of one month. In case the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted, a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
