**AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)**

By this petition the petitioner is praying for a direction to the respondents to release education allowance as per instruction issued by the Government on 04.05.2009.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 08.08.2013 (Annexure P-5) to the respondent No.3 and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to the respondent No.3 to look into the matter and decide his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.3 is directed

to look into the matter/representation (Annexure P-5) and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the petitioner is found entitled to any relief the same be also given to him within a period of one month thereafter.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
