By way of this writ petition, the petitioner seeks re-appointment being a retrenched employee. Counsel for the petitioner states that for the same relief, the petitioner has got issued a legal notice (Annexure P-7) and that at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice within a reasonable time frame.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the receipt of a certified copy of this order and in case the petitioner is found entitled to any relief, the same be granted to him within the aforesaid period.
