The petitioners, by way of present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India inter alia prays for issuance of direction to the respondents to renew their licence in terms of Rule 21(1) of the Haryana Agricultural Produce Markets (General) Rules, 1962 and Haryana Agricultural Produce Markets Act, 1961.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent authority for the grievance raised in the writ petition by filing a detailed and comprehensive representation. Further prayer was made that a direction be issued to the respondents to decide the representation in a time bound manner.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. In case, the petitioners file a representation within a week from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, the same shall be decided by the respondents within a period of

fortnight from the date of receipt of the same by passing a speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, in accordance with law.
