After addressing arguments for some time, counsel for the petitioners prays that though the inquiry has been conducted without affording an opportunity to the petitioners, the writ petition may be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to file a reply and raise all such pleas as may be available to them to prove that the findings recorded in the inquiry are factually and legally incorrect.

In view of the statement made by counsel for the petitioners, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. The S.D.O. (C), Thanesar, Tehsil Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, is, however, directed to afford adequate opportunity to the complainants, the Gram Panchayat and the petitioners to file their response and adduce evidence and only thereafter record his independent opinion, in accordance with law.
