AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for quashing of the Police Verification certificate dated 01.06.2013 (Annexure P-3) issued by the Station House Officer, Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh, District Gurdaspur (now District Pathankot), wherein it has been mentioned that FIR No.37, dated 13.08.2006, under Sections 304-B, 498A, 34 IPC, Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh, was registered against him and he was convicted by the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Juvenile Court, Gurdaspur vide judgement dated 14.12.2011 (Annexure P-1).

This prayer of counsel for the petitioner cannot be accepted in the light of the fact that indeed the petitioner was convicted for offence under Section 498A read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code. The certificate does not indicate that he was convicted for offences under

Sections 304B, 498A and 34 of Indian Penal Code. It only refers to the provisions under which the FIR No.37 dated 13.08.2006 was registered at Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh, for which the trial was held. The intention, thus, as per the certificate dated 01.06.2013 was only that the FIR in question was registered against the petitioner alongwith others under the said Sections of the Indian Penal Code but it does not refer to the Sections under which the petitioner was convicted vide judgement dated 14.12.2011.

With the above observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
