Challenge in the present writ petition is to the order dated 28.04.2003 (Annexures P-6 to P-8) passed by the Arbitrator, respondent No. 5 vide which the petitioner has been directed to deposit the recoverable amount of default of the other defaulter loanies, who have failed to repay the same.

Against any decision or award made under Section 56 of the Punjab Cooperation Societies Act, remedy of appeal has been provided under Section 68(1)(h) of the Punjab Cooperative Societies Act.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail remedy of appeal in accordance with law.
