AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Petitioner had been working for the respondents and had been performing the repair work and supplying the material/articles as per their requirement. The details of the bills which have been duly approved are mentioned in the legal notice dated 08.09.2014 (Annexure P-1) served by the petitioner upon the respondents but the said bills have not been cleared till date and an amount of ₹1,69,272/- is pending due with the respondents.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Superintending Engineer, Public Health, PWD, Palwal, District Palwal and Executive Engineer, Public Health, PWD, Palwal, District Palwal, (respondent No.3 and 4 respectively) to consider and decide the legal notice dated 08.09.2014 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within some specified time.

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In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the Superintending Engineer, Public Health, PWD, Palwal, District Palwal and Executive Engineer, Public Health, PWD, Palwal, District Palwal, (respondent No.3 and 4 respectively) to consider and decide the legal notice dated 08.09.2014 (Annexure P-1) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to the petitioner, in accordance with law, within a further period of six weeks.
