AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that the arms licence possessed by the petitioner is valid in the State of Punjab only, whereas, the petitioner wants it extended to the whole of the country. In pursuance to this, he has submitted an application dated 03.02.2011 (Annexure P-4) to the District Magistrate, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 but the said application till date has not been decided. Petitioner thereafter has served a notice through counsel dated 15.12.2014 (Annexure P-5) upon the respondents but that also has not yielded any result till date.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the District Magistrate, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 to consider and decide the application dated 03.02.2011 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the District Magistrate, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 to consider and decide the application dated 03.02.2011 (Annexure P-4) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
