Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner - Mazdoor Union states that its members confine their claim to being paid fair wages as per law. He states that the tender has already been awarded to a contractor and that the petitioner itself is not interested in seeking a quashing of the tender in favour of the contractor, but only confines its claim to being paid wages as aforesaid.

2. The petition is accordingly disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to adopt appropriate proceedings for the purpose of recovering from and being paid the wages by the contractor in accordance with law.

3. In the meantime, the official respondents shall consider the representation of the petitioner in this regard, for if the representation is decided favourably, it may save the petitioner the trouble of adopting further proceedings.
