The petitioner seeks a direction to the respondents to release the remaining amount of Rs.3,11,489/-, including gratuity, leave encashment, provident fund, pensionary benefits, medical benefits, etc. consequent upon death of her husband on 10.01.2011.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice, Annexure P-2, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.2, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-2, by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
