Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is inter alia for quashing the demand of amount of ₹ 3,33,860/- against the petitioner.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation raising all the points as has been sought to be raised in the writ petition. However, a prayer was made that some time bound direction may be issued to the respondents to decide the representation expeditiously.

3. The writ petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation raising all the points as has been sought to be raised in the writ petition to challenge the demand of ₹ 3,33,860/- raised against the petitioner. If such a

representation is filed within one month from today, the same shall be decided by the concerned respondent within two months from the date of filing thereof after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
