Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner with regard to pay fixation by taking into consideration the benefit granted to him on account of A.C.P. Scheme on completion of 16 years of service. It is also pleaded in the petition that the petitioner has already made representation dated 18.08.2014 (Annexure P-1), but no action is being taken.

Having perused the paper-book, however, without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of without issuing any notice at this stage with a direction to respondent no.2-Director, Health and Family Welfare, Punjab, to consider the claim of the petitioner, as mentioned in Annexure P-1, by passing a speaking order
