The petitioner by way of present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondent-authority to release electricity connection to the petitioner without any further delay.

The petitioner has been allotted a Flat No.306, 4th Floor, vide allotment letter issued in the year 2004 (Annexure P-2). The petitioner is a member of the Society as per certificate of membership (Annexure P-1). The allotment with respect to the aforesaid Flat is covered by the judgments of this Court passed on 31.08.2012 and 07.11.2012 (Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively). The petitioner is not a party in any writ petition nor in any contempt petition, which is pending in this Court.

In view of the judgments of this Court dated 31.08.2012 and 07.11.2012 (Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively), the present petition is

disposed of with a direction to the concerned respondent to pass an appropriate order on legal notice dated 07.04.2015, (Annexure P-8) in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
