The petitioner seeks issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the pensionary benefits on account of the death of her husband.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice, Annexure P-1, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.1, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-4, by passing a speaking order and if found admissible, release the consequential benefits, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
