Counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to pursue his representation dated 24.08.2014 (Annexure P-12) addressed to the Director, Local Bodies, Punjab and also to make a detailed representation to the Principal Secretary, Department of Local Bodies, Punjab-respondent No.1 to highlight the grievances of the petitioners with reference to the various reports, which have been submitted by the authorities pointing out the illegalities and irregularities committed in relation to allotment of plot Nos.44-A and 16-A, M.C. Colony, Fazilka, as these plots have been carved out which was actually a street as per the master plan. He further states that the representation to respondent No.1 will be submitted within a period of four weeks from today, which may be directed to be considered and decided at an early date.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

In case such a representation is made within the time as stated

by counsel for the petitioners, the same shall be looked into and appropriate steps, in accordance with law, be taken by Principal Secretary, Department of Local Bodies, Punjab-respondent No.1 within a period of eight weeks of submission of such representation.
