1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner is praying for a direction to the official respondents to comply with their own norms for allotments of accommodation to employees of HPGCL.

Learned counsel states that the petitioners are entitled to higher category houses but the same have been denied to them and given to the employees who are not entitled. He further states that in this connection the petitioners have also moved Legal Notices (Annexures P-5 to P-14) to the respondents and at this stage they would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.1 to look into the matter and decide their legal notices

within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.1 is directed to look into the matter/legal notices (Annexures P-5 to P-14) and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
