The petitioner seeks counting of service rendered by her in a Privately managed aided school towards pensionary benefits.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice, Annexure P-3, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-3, in the light of the law laid down in ***Sukhdev Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others***, rendered in CWP No.14238 of 1991 (Annexure P-1) by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
