By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to decide the application dated 01.10.2013 (Annexure P1) for restoration of water course of outlet burji No. R.D. 5320/left Nathua Minor.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner had moved an application dated 01.10.2013 (Annexure P-1), however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.2, to decide the application Annexure P-1, by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
