Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing impugned order dated 10.03.2015 (Annexure P/7) passed by respondent no.3 – District Development and Panchayat Officer, Rupnagar, whereby respondent no.5 has been appointed as Administrator.

In pursuance of notice of motion, reply has been filed.

Learned State counsel states that period of Administrator has already expired. Perusal of order dated 10.03.2015 (Annexure P/7)

reveals that appointment of the Administrator was only for three

months, which has already expired in the month of June, 2015.

In view of above, instant writ petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
