By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents Nos. 2 to 4 to initiate the pending inquiry against the respondent No.6 vide letter dated 01.04.2013 issued by respondent No.2 regarding the misappropriation of the panchayat funds within stipulated time.

The learned counsel contends that upon the filing of complaint (Annexure P-2), the respondent No.2 directed the respondent No.4-Deputy Executive Officer, Hoshiarpur, to look into the matter and send details of the investigation within 30 days. Except for this specific order, nothing has been done so far. The learned counsel further submits that despite the repeated communications, no action has been initiated against respondent No.6.

Keeping in view the assertion raised, without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to look into the matter and to pass necessary order within three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the needful is not done within the stipulated time, the petitioner is free to revive the present petition.
