By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks quashing of the Annexure P-3 and for issuance of directions to the respondents to pay interest on the delayed payment of gratuity and leave encashment @ 18% p.a., from the date of its accrual till realization.

The learned counsel contends the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down in **The Financial Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Irrigation Department, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh Vs. Hasan Singh Kanwar, 2010(1) SLR 788.**

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to reconsider the claim of the petitioner and decide the same, in terms of **Hasan Singh Kanwar's** case, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
