By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to issue the mutation deed in favour of the petitioner with respect to land measuring 8 kanals and 1 marla, bearing khasra No. 23 (-1).

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner had moved an application dated 15.02.2015 (Annexure P-5) and also served a legal notice dated 25.03.2015 (Annexure P-6) but in vain.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.2, to decide the application dated 15.02.2015 (Annexure P-5) and legal notice dated 25.03.2015 (Annexure P-6), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
