AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that the fee bills submitted by him to the respondent have not been released to him despite submitting the bills details of which have been mentioned in representation dated 25.08.2014 (Annexure P-2).

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had been approaching the respondent and its authorities for release of the amount due for his fee bills but without any response. He contends that a direction may be issued to the respondent-Haryana State Federation of Consumer's Co-operative Wholesale Stores Ltd. (CONFED) to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner which has been projected by him in his representation dated 25.08.2014 (Annexure P-2), within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the

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petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the respondent-Haryana State Federation of Consumer's Co-operative Wholesale Stores Ltd. (CONFED) to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner which has been projected by him in his representation dated 25.08.2014 (Annexure P-2) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to him within a further period of four weeks, in accordance with law. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
