This petition is identical, in substance, to CWP No.19342 of 2015 (Dr.Jasvir Kaur Chahal and others vs. State of Punjab and others).

The petitioner in this petition was granted extension in service for a period of two years upto 31.5.2015, by the respondent-UT Administration. The interim order allowing the petitioner to continue in service beyond that date, was passed by this Court on 28.5.2015 and the writ petition was ordered to be heard along with CWP No.11988 of 2014.

That petition (CWP No.11988 of 2014), in fact, is of a petitioner who is working as a Professor in the Department of Public Administration, Panjab University, Chandigarh, who, obviously, is not governed by the service Rules, as govern the conditions of service of the petitioner in the present writ petition, i.e. Dr.Pritpal Kaur.

Hence, for the reasons already given in CWP No.19342 of 2015, vide order of even date, the interim order dated 28.5.2015 is hereby vacated in this petition also.

With the same observations as have been made in CWP No.19342 of 2015, vide order of even date, this petition is also directed to be transferred to the learned Central Administrative Tribunal (Chandigarh Bench), for consideration and adjudication.
