There is delay of 11 days in filing the appeal. The same stands condoned on the grounds mentioned in the application.

Main case

This is an appeal directed by insurance company against the Award dated 13.11.2014 passed by Sh. Ajay Kumar Verma, Presiding Officer, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Karnal (for short “the Tribunal”) vide which the claim petition of Ram Charan-claimant in respect of injuries sustained by him in a motor vehicular accident was partly accepted to the tune of Rs.10/- lacs.

Briefly stated Ram Chander filed claim petition claiming compensation on account of the injuries sustained by him in a motor vehicle accident.

The only point urged during the course of argument is regarding quantum.

Learned Tribunal after adjudicating the claim of the parties accepted the claim petition. The Tribunal reached to the conclusion that claimant Ram Chander has suffered disability to the extent of 80% as his right leg was amputated. It is further observed that claimant had a long stay in hospitalization as detailed in Ex. P-1. So, the amount of Rs.10/- lacs in respect of amputation of leg of a Mason cannot be said to be on higher side.

So, in view of above discussion, there is no scope for reduction of the compensation. Consequently, the appeal stands dismissed.
