After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the parties have reached the consensus about the enhancement of compensation amount.

With the consent of learned counsel for the appellants and respondent no. 3-Insurance Company, this appeal is allowed and the amount of compensation awarded to the claimants is increased from ₹9,75,000/- to ₹15,53,416/-. The above amount has been calculated as follows:-

Sr. No.	Heads	Calculation
(i)	Income of the deceased	₹7500 per month
(ii)	30% of (i) above to be added as future prospects	₹7500 + ₹2250 = ₹9750 per month
(iii)	1/4 th of (ii) deducted as personal expenses of the deceased	₹9750 - ₹2438 = ₹7312 per month
(iv)	Compensation after multiplier of 14 is applied	(₹7312X12X14) = ₹ 1228416
(v)	Loss of consortium	₹100000
(vi)	Loss of estate	₹100000
(vii)	Loss of love and affection	₹100000
(viii)	Funeral expenses	₹25000
Total		₹1553416

Respondent no. 3-Insurance Company is directed to pay the above amount by way of demand draft in the name of Jaspal Kaur-appellant no. 1, within a period of six weeks, failing which the Insurance Company shall be liable to pay interest @ 7.5% per annum from the date of filing of the claim petition till the actual realization.
