SHEKHER DHAWAN, J (ORAL)

Appellant has filed the present appeal against award dated 19.11.2014 by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Faridabad (hereinafter referred as 'The Tribunal') for seeking enhancement on account of injuries having been sustained in motor vehicle accident.

2. Facts relevant for the purpose of decision of present appeal are that motor vehicle accident took place on 17.05.2013. Learned counsel for the appellant took the plea that 'The Tribunal' has awarded lesser amount as a sum of Rs.11,210/- was awarded on account of medical expenses, Rs.7,000/- for stay of injured in the hospital, Rs.10,000/- towards pain and suffering and Rs.8,000/- towards loss of income. A total amount of compensation awarded was just Rs.66,210/- along with interest @ 7.5% per annum from the date of claim petition.

3. As in the present case appellant had not suffered any disability, he

has been duly compensated for amount having been spent for his treatment for which bills were produced before 'The Tribunal'. He had not suffered any permanent disability. He has been duly compensated for his actual expenses during stay in the hospital and sufficient amount on account of pain and suffering has already been awarded.

4. Having considered the rival submissions made by learned counsel for appellant, this Court is of the considered view that 'The Tribunal' has rightly awarded the compensation and there are no grounds for interference. There are no justifiable ground for enhancement of compensation.

5. Resultantly the present appeal being without any merit stands dismissed.
