Vide order dated 01.09.2015 a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by ₹3,65,000/- more over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT. Today, learned counsel for the Insurance Company has stated that in fact a multiplier of 17 should be applied instead of 18. If the calculations are made accordingly, there would be increase of ₹3,20,000/- more over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT.

Learned counsel for the appellants as well as learned counsel/representatives of the Insurance Company have made a statement (separately recorded) to settle the matter by payment of another sum of ₹3,20,000/- more over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of ₹3,20,000/- in the name of appellant No.1-Shanti Devi wd/o Shri Jagdish with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 19.01.2016

failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of

this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat.

The appellants' counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
