K.C. PURI J. (Oral)

This is an appeal directed by widow and two major sons of deceased, claiming compensation on account of death of Lachhman Singh in a motor vehicular accident.

This appeal has been directed for enhancement of compensation. The only point urged during the course of arguments is that the amount of Rs.10,000/- towards loss of love and affection and Rs.5,000/- in respect of loss of estate, are on lower side and the amount of compensation should be granted by taking into account the authority "*Vimal Kanwar and others Vs.*

Kishore Dan and others" reported in 2013(2) R.C.R. (Civil) 945.

The aforesaid argument carries weight and has to be accepted.

So, by keeping in view Vimal Kanwar and others case (supra) the claimant is held entitled to claim Rs.1,00,000/- more in respect of loss of love and affection in addition to the amount awarded by the learned Tribunal. The enhanced amount shall carry interest @ 7.5% per annum from the date of application till payment. The liability to pay the aforesaid amount shall be same as ordered by the Tribunal.

Appeal stands disposed of, accordingly.
