This is an application filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condoning the delay of 93 days in filing the appeal.

For the reasons stated in the application, the delay of 93 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

The application stands disposed of.

FAO No.2783 of 2015

1. The instant appeal is for enhancement of compensation with regard to the injuries suffered in a motor accident. The medical expenses incurred had been brought through bills and the entire amount claimed i.e. ₹1,59,180/- was provided. He had complained of three fractures for which assessment was made and the Court below has granted ₹50,000/- for pain and suffering as well as ₹50,000/- for future medical expenses and assessed ₹20,000/- for loss of studies. I find the Tribunal has addressed every possible issue of compensation.

2. I affirm the assessment made by the Court below and dismiss the appeal.
