ARUN PALLI J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that lis between the parties stands amicably resolved and substantively, nothing survives in the appeal and the same be dismissed, as having become infructuous. However, he submits that certain formality remains to be satisfied, thus, he be granted liberty that in case any dispute or interest still survives, appellant shall be entitled to move an appropriate application for its restoration and decision on merits.

Dismissed as infructuous, with liberty as prayed for.
